- Size of injury

- Presence of swelling, tenderness
- Presence of blood, pus, odor, open sore
- Complaints of pain


Examples: 3-inch long deep cut, still bleeding; 2-inch dark purple bruise around right eye, eyelid swollen shut


Look at all parts of the body when elder abuse is suspected, including: heels, buttocks, chest, back, scalp, etc. **Photograph physical injuries. In a case of suspected sexual abuse, follow the appropriate protocols.** 



## Document each physical observation on the body diagrams followed by a description.

Note all areas where pain is present even if there is no visible evidence of injury.
