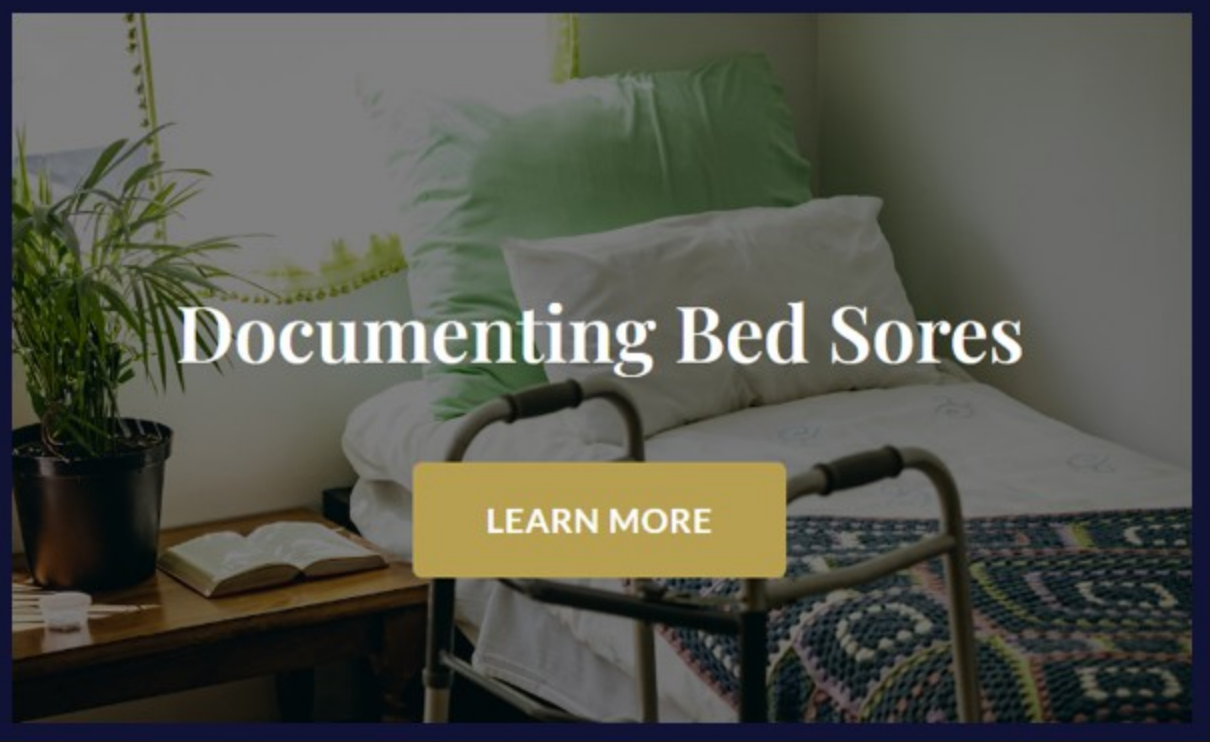


Elder Death Scenes
